CUTTY SARK 8 X 32 J: 3 Cpls (4 cpl set)

Book 40

- 1- 4 1st couple cast *off* and dance down behind their own lines.2nd couple step up, bars 3-4.
- 5- 8 1st couple cast *up* and dance into second place.
- 9-16 2nd and 1st couples dance right hands across; then left hands across.
- 17-18 1st couple turn, right hand, to *face their First Corners*.
- 19-20 1st couple turn First Corner, left hand.
- 21-22 1st couple turn Second Corner, right hand.
- 23-24 1st couple cross, left hand, to second place, on their own side.
- 25-28 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples, nearer hands joined, advance and retire.
- 29-32 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples turn partner, right hand, once round.

THE SAILOR 8 X 32 H: 3 Cpls (4 cpl set)

Book 24

- 1- 2 1st couple cross down, right hand; while, 2nd couple step up.
 Finish: 1st woman face out between 2nd
 - and 3rd men <u>and</u> 1st man *face out* between 2nd and 3rd women.
- 3- 4 Joining nearer hands, set in threes on the sidelines.
- 5- 6 1st woman cast *up* round 2nd man to finish between 2nd couple, all *facing down*; while,

1st man cast *down* round 3rd woman to finish between 3rd couple, all *facing up*.

- 7-8 Joining nearer hands, all set.
- 9-16 Reels of three across the dance. To begin: 1st couple pass the person on their right, right shoulder. Finish: 1st couple in second place, on their opposite side.
- 17-24 1st couple, right hands joined, lead down the middle (2 bars); and up (2 bars); then cross at the top; and cast *into second place*, on their own side.
- 25-32 2nd and 1st couples dance rights and lefts.

THE DUNDEE WHALER

4 X 32 S: 4 Cpls (4 cpl set)

Roy Clowes, Ormskirk Book 1

- 1- 8 2nd and 4th couples dance bars 1-8 of "Petronella".Finish: 2nd and 4th couples in their
 - partner's place.
- 9-16 1st couple with 2nd couple and 3rd couple with 4th couple dance a ladies' chain.
- 17-24 1st and 3rd couples dance bars 1-8 of "Petronella".
 Finish: 1st and 3rd couples in their partner's place.
- 25-26 1st woman change place with 2nd man, left hand.
- 27-28 1st man change place with 2nd woman <u>and</u> 1st woman change place with 3rd woman, right hand.
- 29-30 1st man change place with 3rd man <u>and</u> 1st woman change place with 4th man, left hand.
- 31-32 1st man change place with 4th woman, right hand.

CIRCASSIAN CIRCLE ORCADIAN STYLE 5 X 32 R: Cpls (Round the Room)

Collected from Mrs. Wilma Taylor in Kirkwall, Orkney

One circle round the room, men with their partner on their right: all *face in*.

- 1- 2 All take nearer hands and advance.
- 3- 4 All, retaining hold, retire.
- 5- 8 All repeat bars 1-4. Finish: all release hands.
- 9-12 The women advance and clap; then retire
- 13-16 The men advance and pull left shoulder back; then dance out to the next woman (the one originally on his left). Finish: the men, backs to the centre, face their new partner.
- 17-20 All set to their new partner.
- 21-24 All take their new partner in birl hold (right arm elbow grip, left hands gripped above right forearms) and turn by the right. Finish: all, in promenade hold, face round the set, clockwise.
- 25-32 All promenade their new partner clockwise round the room.

THE CAPTAIN'S HOUSE

8 X 32 R: 3 Cpls (4 cpl set) Holly Boyd, *Third Graded Book*

1- 4 1st couple turn, right hand, once round.

- 5- 6 1st couple cast *off* one place; <u>while</u>, 2nd couple step up.
- 7-8 1st couple cross, left hand. Finish: 1st couple, at second place on their opposite side, *face out*.
- 9-16 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples dance reels of three on the sides.
 To begin: 1st couple pass their Second Corner, left shoulder.
 Finish: 1st couple face their First Corner.
- 17-20 1st couple dance a diagonal half reel of four with their First Corners.At the end, 1st couple pass each other, right shoulder, to face their Second Corner.
- 21-24 1st couple dance half a diagonal reel of four with their Second Corners.
 Finish: 1st couple in second place on their opposite side.
- 25-28 3rd, 1st and 2nd couples turn their partner, right hand, once round.
- 29-32 3rd, 1st and 2nd couples dance clockwise halfway round the set.
 Finish: all on their own side in the order 2, 1, 3.

INTERVAL

OVER THE WATER TO CHARLIE (NEW WAY) 8 X 32 J: 3 Cpls (4 cpl set)

Book 34

- 1-8 1st couple set; then cast *off* one place; and dance down, nearer hands joined, between 3rd couple; then divide and cast *up* to second place.

 2nd couple step up, bars 3-4.
- 9-12 2nd and 1st couples dance right hands across, halfway, and remain in the centre; then join right hand with their partner and cross to their original place.
- 13-14 1st and 2nd couples dance left hands across, halfway, and remain in the centre.
- 15-16 Joining left hand with partner: 1st couple turn to face their First Corner; while, 2nd couple cross to top place, on their own side.
- 17-24 1st couple set to and turn corners. Finish: 1st couple *face their First Corner*.
- 25-30 1st couple dance left shoulder reels of three with their corners.
- 31-32 1st couple cross, right hand, to second place, on their own side.

JESSIE'S HORNPIPE

8 X 32 R: 3 Cpls (4 cpl set)

Book 8

- 1- 8 1st couple dance figures of eight, on their own side, round 2nd and 3rd couples.

 To begin: 1st couple pass 2nd couple, right shoulder.
- 9-16 1st couple lead down the middle and up.

- Finish: 1st couple, in the centre, face 2nd couple.
- On bar 16, 2nd couple step in to *face 1st couple*. (All have nearer hands joined.)
- 17-18 1st couple dance to second place under an arch made by 2nd couple, who dance up to top place.

 Finish: 2nd and 1st couples face each other

in the middle.

- 19-20 2nd couple dance to second place under an arch made by 1st couple, who dance up to top place.Finish: 1st and 2nd couples face each other in the middle.
- 21-22 1st and 2nd couples repeat bars 17-18.
- 23-24 2nd and 1st couples repeat bars 19-20. Finish: 1st and 2nd couples in the centre, both hands joined, ready for:
- 25-32 1st and 2nd couples dance a poussette.

THE MINISTER ON THE LOCH

3 X 32 S: 3 Cpls (3 cpl set)

Roy Goldring, Four Dances 2008

- 1-8 1st and 2nd couples dance a poussette.
- 9-16 1st couple dance down the middle (2 bars); then turn, both hands, once round (2 bars); and dance up (2 bars); then turn, both hands, once round, to finish in the centre, facing up.
- 17-24 1st and 3rd couples dance double figures of eight around the standing 2nd couple.
 To begin, 1st couple cast off and 3rd couple cross up.
 Finish: 1st couple, in their original place, face out.
- 25-28 1st and 2nd couples change place:
 1st and 2nd women turn, right hand, 1½
 times; while, 1st and 2nd men turn, left
 hand, 1½ times.
 Finish: 1st couple face in.
- 29-32 1st and 3rd couples change place:
 1st and 3rd women turn, left hand, 1½
 times; while, 1st and 3rd men turn, right
 hand, 1½ times.

BRITANNIA TWO STEP

6 X 16 Mar: Trios (Round the Room)

Collected by Johan Maclean, A Guide to SCD

In trios (man between two women, or woman between two men) facing the line of dance.

- 1- 2 All place left heel forward, toe backward; then dance a skip change of step to the left.
- 3- 4 All place right heel forward, toe backward; then dance a skip change of step to the right.
- 5- 6 All walk forward: left, right, left, swing

- right.
- 7-8 All walk backward: right, left, right, swing left
- 9-10 All dance two pas de basque on the spot
- 11-12 All dance two pas de basque to turn outside under centre person's arms.
- 13-14 All walk forward: left, right, left, swing right.
- 15-16 All walk backward: right, left, right, swing left.

THE ROYAL YACHT BRITANNIA

8 X 40 R: 3 Cpls (4 cpl set)

John Drewry (2002), Book 43

- 1- 2 1st couple set to each other.
- 3- 4 1st couple dance (nearer hands) down to second place and *face out*.
 2nd couple step up.
- 5-8 1st man dance down behind 3rd man, then into the middle and up; while, 1st woman dance up behind 2nd woman, then into the middle and down.

 Finish: 1st couple left shoulder to left
- shoulder.
 9-12 Right hands across: 1st man with 2nd and 3rd women <u>and</u> 1st woman with 2nd and 3rd men.
 On bar 12, 1st couple dance towards each other to finish in the middle, right shoulder to right shoulder.
- 13-16 Left hands across: 1st man with 2nd and 3rd men <u>and</u> 1st woman with 2nd and 3rd women.

Finish: 1st couple face First Corners.

- 17-18 1st couple set to First Corners.
- 19-20 1st couple dance (skip change) round each other, by the right, to *face Second Corners*.
- 21-22 1st couple set to Second Corners.
- 23-24 1st couple dance round each other, by the right, to second place, own side, and *face out*.
- 25-32 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples dance reels of three on the sides.To begin: 2nd and 1st men and 1st and 3rd women pass right shoulder.
- 33-40 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples dance six hands round and back.

EXTRAS

THE TRI-MARINER 8 X 32 R: 3 Cpls (4 cpl set)

Ann Dix, Book 48

1- 8 1st couple set; then cast off two places; and lead up to the top.
Finish in the centre: 1st couple, in promenade hold, face up.
At the same time, 2nd couple stand (2 bars); then set; and cast off one place; then lead up one place.
Finish below 1st couple: 2nd couple, in

- promenade hold, face up.

 At the same time, 3rd couple stand (4 bars); then set; and cast round own place. Finish below 2nd couple: 3rd couple, in promenade hold, face up.
- 9-16 1st, 2nd and 3rd couples dance a promenade.
 On bars 15-16, 1st couple cast off to second place; while, 2nd couple dance up to first place; and 3rd couple finish in their original place.
- 17-20 1st couple cross, right hand, below 3rd couple; then cast *up* to second place on their opposite side.
- 21-24 1st couple cross, right hand, above 2nd couple; then cast *into second place* on their own side.
- 25-28 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples dance a "Petronella" turn into the middle; then all set
- 29-32 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples turn, right hand, 1¼ times, to their own side.

After their second time through: in bars 3-4, the original 1st couple step down; while, the original 4th couple (as new 3rd couple) step up; in bars 5-6, the new 3rd couple set.

THE DHOON 4 X 32 J: 4 Cpls (4 cpl set)

Jessie Hamilton, SCDs For Children

- 1- 4 Joining hands on the sides, all dance four small slip steps to the right and four small slip steps back to place.
- 5-8 All turn partner, right hand, once round.
- 9-12 Joining hands on the sides, all dance four small slip steps to the left and four small slip steps back to place.
- 13-16 All turn partner, left hand, once round.
- 17-18 1st couple cast *off* one place and meet in the middle, nearer hands joined, *facing up*.
- 19-20 1st couple dance to the top.
- 21-24 1st couple cast *to the bottom* of the set. 2nd, 3rd and 4th couples, joining hands on the side, step up, bars 23-24.
- 25-32 All dance eight hands round and back.

THE SWAN AND THE TAY

3 X 32 S: 3 Cpls (3 cpl set)

Audrey Saunders, Perth 800

- 1- 8 1st couple dance figures of eight on their own side, giving hands to partner when possible.
 - To begin: 1st couple dance in and down.
- 9-16 1st couple cross through second place on their opposite side to dance reels of three with 2nd and 3rd couples (giving hands to partner when possible).

To begin: 2nd couple dance out and up <u>and</u> 3rd couple dance in and up.

Finish: 2nd couple in first place on their own side <u>and</u> 1st couple *face their First Corner*.

- 17-20 1st couple and First Corners dance Corners Pass and Turn.
 - 17 First Corners dance in, passing 1st man or 1st woman, right shoulder.

 At the same time, 1st couple dance out towards the corner place.
 - 18 First Corners turn each other, right hand, to face their corner place.

 At the same time, 1st couple curve round by the right through the corner place to face in.
 - 19 First Corners dance out towards their corner place, passing 1st man or 1st woman, right shoulder.

 At the same time, 1st couple dance into the middle.
 - 20 First corners curve round by the right into their own corner place.

 At the same time, 1st couple dance round each other, right shoulder, to face their Second Corners.
- 21-24 1st couple and Second Corners dance Corner Pass and Turn.

At the end, 1st couple pass partner, right shoulder.

Finish: 1st couple in second place on their own side.

- 25-28 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples set; then cross, right hand, to their opposite side and *face clockwise*.
- 29-32 2nd, 1st and 3rd couples dance halfway round.

Finish: all on their own side in the order 3, 1, 2.
